Treasurer's Report

Tony presented the FY05 financial statement prepared by MASFAA's accountant. He explained that the money spent out of last year's reserves was to cover unexpected Conference expenses as well as the new Just the Facts training. Tony reported that MASFAA has one year's operating expenses in reserves and that we are currently budgeted to have a small surplus at the end of FY06. Tony reported that MASFAA has invested \$50,000 of its reserve funds with Edward Jones and that we plan to invest another \$50,000 by the end of the year. Tony explained that the financial statement includes income and expenses for College Goal Sunday but that these funds will be split out in the future. Tony reported that all sponsorship funds received for College Goal Sunday were used in their entirety to fund this program. The Treasurer's Report was accepted as presented by a unanimous vote.

New Business

Cathy introduced the Just the FACTS program. She announced the names of the graduates from last season and passed out certificates of completion.

A motion to adjourn was offered by Tony Erwin and seconded by Donna Wood Lozier. The meeting was adjourned at 1:20 P.M.
